TO YOUR COMMUNITY?
START A GIRL ACTION TEAM!**

Be a part of GFC – Start a Girl Action Team!

Girl advocates can start up to five (5) Girl Action Teams in a community. Girl Action Teams are made of 10-12 girls and two women volunteers. Girls identify a community topic they want to address and then design and implement a social change project that focuses on the issue. **GFC is open to girls in 6th-12th grade.**

Through GFC's licensing model, advocates can partner with GFC to raise funds and recruit volunteers. Teams must be started in partnership with a school or community based organization.



What It Takes:

- A liaison who is connected to a school or organization that can host the Girl Action Team
- 1-2 women volunteers who will be GFC Coaches for the 12-week program
- Ability to raise the money needed for the team or partner with GFC in doing so

The Cost:

If cost is a barrier, please do not let this stop you from applying for a team. There may be opportunities for funding collaboration in your community. (Note: *1 team is one 12-week session at one site)

- Public and Charter Schools or Organizations with up to \$500,000 annual operating budget:
 - Year 1 = \$5000 for 1-2 teams* + \$500 for each additional team
 - Year 2 and Beyond = \$2,500 for 1-2 teams + \$500 for each additional team
- Private and Independent Schools or Organizations with annual operating budget of \$501k to \$1 million:
 - Year 1 = \$7500 for 1-2 teams + \$500 for each additional team
 - Year 2 and Beyond = \$3,750 for 1-2 teams + \$500 for each additional team
- Organizations with over \$1 million annual operating budget:
 - Year 1 = \$10,000 for 1-2 teams* + \$500 for each additional team.
 - Year 2 and Beyond = \$5,000 for 1-2 teams + \$500 for each additional team.

What GFC Provides:

- Recognition of the partnership, opportunities for national media exposure and use of the GFC logo
- Trainings via webinar for volunteer Coaches and online resources for Coaches
- GFC Starter Kit – includes Coach Toolbox, Girl Action Kit and more! New curriculum modules and materials released regularly!
- Ongoing GFC staff support by email and phone, including access to America Learns reporting service

WANT TO BRING GFC TO YOUR COMMUNITY? License a Region!

Be a change agent – license a region!

Girl advocates can license an entire region and bring Girls For A Change to many girls in a community. A licensed region includes the ability to start unlimited Girl Action Teams within an agreed upon geographic region and extensive support and training from GFC. Licenses are available to 501c3 organizations, NGOs and school districts.

Girl Action Teams are made of 10-12 girls and two women volunteers. Girls identify a community topic they want to address and then design and implement a social change project that focuses on the issue. **GFC is open to girls in 6th-12th grade.**

What It Takes:

- Appropriate staffing levels for implementing GFC program in 12-week sessions
- Ability to raise the money needed for the licensing partnership
- Strong history of community involvement and implementation of programming
- Commitment to social change, youth development and girl empowerment

The Cost:

Please contact us regarding the cost of licensing a GFC region. This cost is based on several factors including, but not limited to:

- Size of the region being licensed
- Amount of possible teams in the region
- Organizational budget

What GFC Provides:

- High level recognition of the partnership, opportunities for national media exposure and use of the GFC logo and brand
- Extensive training for all staff members involved in GFC implementation
- Ongoing GFC staff support by email and phone, including access to America Learns reporting service
- Access to all GFC curriculum and implementation materials, including new curriculum modules developed as they are developed
- Evaluation package that provides local results for use in program promotion, grants, etc.
